Product Carbon Footprint Verification Letter

Carbon Trust Assurance Limited (**'The Company'**) verifies that:

Dyson Technology Ltd (**'You'**) has submitted for verification purposes the calculated 224 Listed Carbon Footprints of the following 20 Listed Stock Keeping Units (SKUs) and 2 Listed Products sold Cradle-to-Grave (Business-to-Consumer) and marketed in the Listed Geographical Areas, in accordance with:

- PAS 2050:2011 – Specification for the assessment of the life cycle greenhouse gas emissions of goods and services
- Product Carbon Footprints: Requirements for Assurance v3
- Product Consistency Criteria (PCC)

Listed Products, SKUs and Carbon Footprints

Cradle-to-Grave Carbon Footprint Subsequent Verification Results

The Company verifies the product carbon footprint results set out in the supplementary Excel file ('PCF Assurance Letter - Supplementary document v1.0 - Dyson CERT-13582'). This is the second time that these Product Carbon Footprint Results have been verified by the Company.

Carbon footprint reduction results to compare results to the previous verification were not calculated. This is due to improvements in the methodology and updates in grouping rules in Carbon Trust Requirements for Assurance v3.



The Company verifies the above Listed Carbon Footprints based on the supply chains and data provided in the following model:

2022 Verification

FPX Multi SKU Dyson v3.7

The above models use Footprint Expert™ data version 4.5 and calculators - version 4.7.

Level of Assurance

This certification was carried out to a Reasonable Level of Assurance.

Materiality

It has been verified that all material non-conformities identified during the sampling performed on the footprint models submitted have been closed. If at any time and for whatever reason You or the Company identify any further non-conformities, the terms described in the Description of Service and General Terms and Conditions will apply. It is also Your duty to promptly inform the Company in writing.

Provision for material discrepancy

The Company has performed the verification in accordance with the applicable material discrepancy threshold: where actual errors, omissions or misrepresentations affect the final footprint result by the equivalent of 1% or more individually or 5% or more in aggregate they are predetermined to be a material discrepancy and therefore a non-conformity.

Product (SKU Group) Level Verification

In the context of this Verification Letter a SKU is a distinct good/service which can be purchased by a consumer or other end user and is distinguishable from another similar good/service.

It has been verified that the 20 SKUs listed above could be grouped into 2 Products with 2 variations each based on the following criteria:

- Materially similar supply chains;
- Functional equivalence; and,
- Degree of control (owned/operated) over the SKU by the footprinting organisation.

Communication of the Listed Carbon Footprint results should only be made in association with the listed SKUs.

Suspended Non-conformities

The following non-conformities were raised but considered suitable for action prior to the next surveillance and/or verification audit. In general, it is expected that Minor Non-conformities should be closed with higher priority than Observations.

1	Distribution is assumed only to occur via shipping and road. Dyson were unable to provide logistics invoices to verify these modes.	For subsequent verifications, Dyson should be able to provide more sufficient evidence.	Minor non-conformity

2	Biogenic removals not reported separately. This relates to an immaterial part of the footprint (<0.1%).	For subsequent verifications, biogenic removals should be reported separately.	Opportunity for Improvement
3	Manufacturing data was not requested in this round of verification.	In the future Dyson should prepare to provide manufacturing data covering the footprint period.	Opportunity for Improvement

Communications

In accordance with the Footprint Protocol and Brand Guidelines You are permitted to communicate the verified results, as set out below and in any associated Annex:

- The verified numbers and products published in the Product Emission Report (Lower Label Report_Certification - paper towels only).
- The result presented in this letter shall be used for public reporting and are the sum of all emissions and removals, both biogenic and fossil. A breakdown of these emissions is presented in the Product Emissions Report.
- The Product Carbon Footprint of this product has been verified by the Carbon Trust.
- When communicating a Carbon Footprint result at the product level (i.e. group of SKUs), communications must be clear that the result is only representative of the Listed SKUs within the group.

Any claims or communication made during the Verification Period shall comply with the Product Carbon Footprints: Requirements for Assurance v3 and Brand Guidelines. Any communications, other than those listed above, shall be submitted to the Company for prior approval and may be documented in an Annex of this Verification Letter at the Company's discretion.
